There's plenty of speed in this year's Derby Trial and the winner figures to be one that's got some closing kick. RUBLE has been strictly on the improve since adding blinkers and posted a career-best "fig" last time out when going a mile at Gulfstream. A good recent work here suggests he's none the worse for wear and his tactical speed makes him a good fit. RULER OF LOVE was a game second his dirt debut and could pop at a price here if he moves forward off that race.
