Four-year-old, who is also first on Prime Power, Back Speed and Average Class Last 3, is trained by Bill Mott who wins with 19% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days plus and with 16% of his starters on grass. Filly can be running from off the pace with Julien Leparoux up.

#7 APRIORITY (Race 7) Son of Grand Slam is first on BRIS Current and Average Class Last 3 and was very game when winning the Mr. Prospector Stakes here in December after stumbling badly at the start in his first race since finishing sixth in the Breeders' Cup Sprint. Five-year-old has now won all three of his previous starts at Gulfstream for trainer David Fawkes who wins with 20% of his runners in non-graded stakes.
