Bay Gelding, (Feb), by Quiet American - Lettuce Loose by Malagra. Trainer Jeanssonne Albin. Bred by Brittlyn Stable Inc.(LA). OIL AMERICAN broke to the outside a bit but with the field, fell well back off the pace the first three furlongs, came four wide out of the turn, shaken up, finished well while out in the strip, in time. BLUE FUSE dueled up front while off the inside, shook clear in the turn, continued to hold a considerable advantage with a furlong remaining, could not contain the winner, held the place. DIFFICULT TO CATCH in the second flight while off the inside, raced in the three path turning for home, getting to the runner up while not a serious threat to the winner. DANTZ lacked speed, raced five wide out of the turn, staged a modest rally to improve position. WHOA WHAM forwardly placed while off the rail, had little left for the drive. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L lacked a late bid in an even effort. PASS BY THE HOUSE alternated up front inside the runner up, gave way before a half. DISWON steadied at the start, not a threat. LITTLE BOY ROY was never a factor. ALOHA DEALS steadied at the start, trailed throughout.
