By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstakes, 5 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 12, 2011 with 37 nominations. (Clear 49)

Bay Gelding, (Jan), by Street Sense - Shawgatny by Danzig Connection. Trainer Wilkes R. Ian. Bred by Lantern Hill Farm LLC(KY). MOTOR CITY was shuffled back between horses early, tucked in to save ground, slipped through entering the stretch, caught SEVEN LIVELY SINS with a furlong to run, kicked clear and maintained a diminishing advantage. SEVEN LIVELY SINS opened clear to set the pace, turned back the bid of FINE and CHALYBEATE SPRINGS leaving the turn, was headed inside the furlong marker, dug back in and came again too late. MR. BOWLING settled into stride, made an early move between horses, angled to the inside on the turn, lacked room entering the stretch, worked his way back to the outside but lacked the needed late response. FINE stalked the pace three wide, launched his bid between horses, but weakened during the drive and faded. CHALYBEATE SPRINGS was close up four wide through the turn and retreated. HOLLYWOOD SCRIPT was hustled along four wide, was floated out further entering the stretch and came up empty in the drive. PURELY DETERMINED was through early.
