The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equal ly among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 other than restricted stake at a mile or over, or three races, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 5, 2007 with 29 Nominations. (Clear 71)

PROM SHOES argued the pace while three wide, responded when roused turning for home, dug in gamely in the stretch and just missed. FEARLESS VISION raced in hand outside, advanced four wide on the turn and dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch. HAL'S MY HOPE argued the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. SIR WHIMSEY was urged along inside, raced on the rail and had no response when roused. SOARING BY contested the pace while between rivals and tired after the opening three quarters.
