By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, October 27, 2011. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Friday, October 28, 2011. The maximum numbers of starters for the Ack Ack Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 19, 2011 with 27 nominations. (Cloudy 55)

Chestnut Gelding, (Mar), by Belong to Me - Miss Marta by Cure the Blues. Trainer Block M. Chris. Bred by Lothenbach Stables(KY).

MISTER MARTI GRAS rated comfortably while racing towards the inside, picked up momentum leaving the five sixteenths marker, swung out six wide for the drive, closed determinedly under left handed pressure, was brushed by ALMA D'ORO when that one came out late then forged ahead in the final strides. ALMA D'ORO, under snug rating in the three path while well within range, eased out a bit edging closer leaving the far turn, worked his way out to the five path for the drive, rallied to a short lead inside the sixteenth marker, came out a bit late brushing the winner while under left handed encouragement, battled gamely but just failed to withstand the winner's charge. GLENWOOD CANYON prompted the pace three to four wide, moved to challenge after six furlongs, disputed the issue between foes inside the eighth pole then lacked the needed finish. GLADDING cleared early, set a slow pace off the inside, took pressure past the five sixteenths pole, briefly edged back clear a furlong out, drifted out through the final sixteenth and weakened. DEMARCATION settled off the pace while four wide, came under a strong ride around the final turn, shifted out very wide in the drive but failed to generate a solid run. EQUESTRIO, unhurried early saving ground, angled out entering the lane but lacked a rally. NACHO FRIEND hopped at the break, was sent up soon after then angled off the rail entering the first turn, attended the pace in the three path under rating, lodged a mild bid leaving the far turn, was pushed along mid way on the final turn, failed to keep pace and faltered.
