Bay Filly, (Feb), by Medaglia d'Oro - Champagne Glow by Saratoga Six. Trainer Guillot J. Eric. Bred by Liberation Farm(KY).

CHAMPAGNE D'ORO sprinted clear on the rail, raced uncontested on the lead along the inside, extended her advantage in midstretch and held off the runner-up under strong right hand urging. AMEN HALLELUJAH was in hand between horses, checked slightly and altered course five wide at the quarter pole then closed strongly in the middle of the track but could not get up. TANDA was outrun for a half after breaking slowly, checked in traffic at the five-eighths pole, circled six wide while rapidly closing the gap at the quarter pole then rallied belatedly from outside. QUIET TEMPER steadied in tight at the half mile pole, raced in traffic on the turn then closed late between rivals.

BUCKLEUPBUTTERCUP pressed the winner from outside into upper stretch and tired. SEEKING THE TITLE raced inside for a half, was shuffled back on the turn, swung sever wide and came back on in the middle of the track. TIDAL POOL checked after breaking slowly, was outrun for a half, circled six wide and closed late from outside. CRISP raced in midpack, gained four wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. INDIAN BURN was pinched back after breaking slowly and never reached contention while wide throughout. MUCH REJOICING pressed three wide between horses to the turn and gave way. DANCES WITH ASHLEY broke in the air at the start, rushed up inside, chased for five furlongs while saving ground and faltered. STREAKER raced just off the pace in traffic for five furlongs and gave way.
