IT'S TRICKY patiently stalked the pacesetter well out in the track down the backstretch, continued to track that opponent, coaxed three wide around the turn, ranged up when ready leaving the five-sixteenths pole, moved past SAVVY SUPREME to take over before reaching the quarter pole, with the rider having kept something in reserve throughout that successful move, felt the top one's presence and was set down to a drive soon after settling into upper stretch, had that rival nearly draw alongside with an eighth to go, dug in with good determination, turned away the challenger and drew off, crossing the finish under a vigorous hand ride. TURBULENT DESCENT placed under a good hold after leaving the starting gate, tracked the pacesetter while racing along the outside, picked up speed and wrested the four path away from SNOW FALL midway on turn, gradually advanced in the right direction, still unasked for run, turned for home and resumed her rally, was perched just off IT'S TRICKY'S hind quarters when let out, failed to keep pace thereafter, falling back steadily, and had to settle for being clearly second best. HER SMILE got off a sluggish beginning after lunging at the start, was only the member of this field of six to take the inside route, approached the quarter pole already having been put to encouragement, angled outward and was up for the show. VICTORIA'S WILDCAT along the outside, was coaxed on the turn, failed to reach a contending position. SNOW FALL four wide departing the backstretch, was pushed outward one additional path by the runner up at the three-eighths pole, was through after completing three-quarters. SAVVY SUPREME broke on top, was rated the two path while carving the pace, yielded readily once confronted by the top one nearing the end of the turn and wilted.
