1 MILE. (1:32¹) STAKES. Purse \$700,000 Acorn S.FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEARS-OLD. By subscription of \$700 which should accompany the nomination. \$5,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$5,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$10,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided accordingly, \$375,000 to the winner, \$130,000 to second, \$70,000 to third, \$46,000 to fourth, \$30,000 to fifth, \$20,000 to sixth, \$16,000 to seventh and \$13,000 to eighth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$500,000 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake, 4 lbs.; of two races at a mile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter, 6 lbs.; of such a race at a mile or over, 8 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winningowner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, May 28, 2016 with 22 Nominations. (Clear 77)

CARINA MIA took back during the early stages, kept watch on the front runners coaxed along in the two path, tipped out wider during the last few jumps of the run around the bend in preparation for the stretch, swung four wide into it and was given her cue, shifted inward, following the lead of CATHRYN SOPHIA until in the two path by the eighth pole, wrested away the lead and edged away, crossing the wire under a hand drive. OFF THE TRACKS veered inward after losing her footing springing from the starting gate, settled into two path, was kept on hold, in need of optimal racing clearance coming to the quarter pole, had enough room to swing out for freedom deep into the furlong grounds, did just that altering course towards the path four, rallied willingly for the place. CATHRYN SOPHIA came away without apparent mishap and cut over into the two path, vied from between rivals throughout the going from the top of the turn to its end, struck the front by a narrow margin at the quarter pole, with the winner bearing down hard, angled over to the rail, crossing over a now-weakening PAOLA QUEEN in midstretch, put up some fight before having the top one snatch away the advantage, then weakened into the show slow. GO MAGGIE GO departed the backstretch from the three path, was the outermost of a trio disputing the pace on the turn, got roused leaving the five-sixteenths marker, commenced the stretch more in the four path than before, gave way in the final furlong. PAOLA QUEEN got guided over to the rail after the break, was forced to fend off a couple of opponents parked out in paths two and three respectively on the turn, was put to a drive nearing the five-sixteenths pole, relinquished soon afterwards, was backing away when steadied after being cut off by CATHRYN SOPHIA in midstretch. FOREVER DARLING got steadied after pushed in by OFF THE TRACKS right after the break, was sent over towards the middle of the strip down the backstretch, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide, the widest of all into the lane, lacked a response.
