Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Graeme Hall - Elegant Designer by Suave Prospect. Trainer Stewart Dallas. Bred by Tommy Hewett(LA). WHO'S IN TOWN bumped with THANK YOU MARYLOU after bobbling inward at the break, went on a few a couple of more jumps then

made contact in the area of the hind quarters with DESIGNER LEGS, moved up willingly under a good hold from the pilot and grabbed the lead shortly afterwards, sat entrenched in the two path, showing the way on a narrow advantage, feeling the presence of a pair, parked out in paths

three and four, turned for home and was set down, drifted inward slightly, tightening things enough for FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD and causing its pilot to steady with some loss of momentum in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was under heavy assault from the same opponent a sixteenth later, came in sharply, rider pulling with solid force on the left rein at the time, putting FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD yet once more in tight

quarters, bumped with that foe getting turned sideways, forged on ahead without the rider ever having ceased asking the mount for run digging in with good determination to be the first to cross the finish line. DESIGNER LEGS bumped lightly with CHARMED HOUR departing the gate,

then made contact with the unofficial winner after being pulled away, secured a forward position by the top of the turn, was in the four path,

pressing the issue as the widest of a threesome, spun into the lane still vying for the lead and was set down, brushed with WHO'S IN TOWN

with less than a sixteenth to go, fought with vigor to the end but couldn't go by. THANK YOU MARYLOU was bumped from both sides at the start, was isolated from the others mostly in the two path while giving chase, fanned five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and gained ground readily en route for the show award. FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD made contact with THANK YOU MARYLOU a few strides after

the start, took the inside route, pulling on the bit in the early going, sat more patiently pocketed thereafter, cut the corner lacking optimal clearance, was steadied when inadvertently put in tight by WHO'S IN TOWN in upper stretch, closed in resolutely to loom a bold threat with a furlong remaining, got squeezed into tight quarters a second time by the previously-mentioned rival near the sixteenth pole, bumping solidly

with that rival before getting checked out of contention. HOP THE SIX broke on top, the only member of the field completely unscatched at the break, got overtaken by WHO'S IN TOWN before completing the opening quarter, was in the three path pressing the issue from between rivals on the turn, began to back away nearing the head of the stretch. CHARMED HOUR came inward leaving the gate, making contact with DESIGNER LEGS, broke down nearing the half mile pole and was euthanized on the track. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the

stretch run, WHO'S IN TOWN was disqualified from first and placed fourth for causing interference.
