SUE'S FORTUNE five paths off the inside down the backstretch in pursuit from striking range, tucked four wide into the turn and advanced on the top pair to stack outside them three furlongs from home under light coaxing, took over command inside the five-sixteenths, swung three then two wide straightened away into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, got momentarily geared down inside the sixteenth marker, had the rider peer at the video board and aspy a late charging rival, got put once more to hand urging and held safe to prevail on the wire. VIRGINIA ELOISE away with the field, settled in behind rivals four wide and began to climb and stride awkwardly when taking the kickback from rivals in front, tipped out to the five path to be clear of it and grew detached at the tail of the field as a result, got coaxed along from the get go, chased four wide through the turn beginning to close the gap by midway, went four to five wide into upper stretch, closed well outside to issue a tepid late threat surging to the wire but was ultimately staved off in a good effort. GUACAMOLE broke in at the start bumping MUCHO AMOR, chased four wide coaxed along from the start, tucked to the inside half a mile from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and ran on to secure the show honors. MUCHO AMOR bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe, who broke inwards, came under coaxing and pressed the pace of LYRICAL LADY from the outside in the three path, had the eventual winner advance outside near the three-eighths and fought between foes from that station to the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong, LYRICAL LADY got brushed at the start by GRANDMA GERTIE who broke inwards and came under hustling to establish the front, cut the pace from the two path lightly coaxed along under pressure from MUCHO AMOR to the outside, knocked heads as that foe advance and vied inside a pair through the turn from the three-eighths to the five-sixteenths, yielded command nearing the quarter pole, cornered just off the inside for home at that station and tired in the drive. GRANDMA GERTIE a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke in at the break brushing LYRICAL LADY, chased three wide down the backstretch in aim of the front coaxed along, got shaken off at the nine-sixteenths, faded through the turn tucked to the two path, continued to retreat and continued just off the inside for home, then faltered in the stretch.
