DESERT CODE sped to the early lead, set all the pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn, kicked clear and held under urging. ALBERTUS MAXIMUS stalked the pace outside then alongside a rival, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, tracked the winner outside on the second turn, came out in the stretch and was second best. COBALT BLUE close up stalking the pace outside a rival or a bit off the rail, bid between horses leaving the backstretch, continued just off the inside on the second turn and in the stretch and just held third between foes late. TIME TO GET EVEN pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail throughout, lacked the needed rally but shared fourth. AWESOME GAMBLER settled a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response while three deep on the line.
