Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Pollard's Vision - Lucky One by Best of Luck. Trainer Hollendorfer Jerry. Bred by Fairlawn Farm(KY).

BLIND LUCK dropped back at the start then was quickly guided to the rail, raced inside on the first turn, was unhurried at the back while off the rail on the backstretch, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole, moved closer without much encouragement, was asked to pick it up coming to the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside under strong left hand urging, drifted in when coming to the leaders near the furlong marker, gained a slim advantage passing the sixteenth-pole and gamely prevailed under strong handling. HAVRE DE GRACE was eased back in the run into the first turn then dropped to the rail, was well placed just behind the leader on the inside, shifted three wide and was asked coming to the three-eighths pole, accelerated to tackle the leader, gained the lead leaving the far turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch, led gamely into the final furlong, tried determinedly to hold off the fast closing winner but was denied. ACTING HAPPY moved out in the early going and herded rivals to the outside, dropped to the rail early on the first turn, moved out again early on the backstretch, set the pace, vied inside while under some urging on the far turn, lost the lead entering the stretch, came off the rail, drifted in under right hand urging nearing the furlong marker, fought resolutely on the inside into the final sixteenth then gave way grudgingly. DEVIL MAY CARE was carried out in the early going then taken in hand and dropped behind the leaders, settled while off the rail, gradually moved out on the backstretch, moved closer while four wide and under urging on the far turn, held a good striking position into upper stretch but lacked the needed response and weakened. TIZAHIT was carried out in the early going, raced three then two wide on the first turn, was carried out again early on the backstretch, prompted the leader on the outside, was urged on the far turn, dropped out at the top of the stretch and gave way. CONNIE AND MICHAEL hit the gate at the start, was carried out in the early going, raced four then three wide on the first turn, was carried out again early on the backstretch, raced just off the pace on the outside, came under a ride with a half-mile to run, dropped out on the far turn and stopped.
