DUNBAR ROAD showed early speed on the inside of three opponents before being eased back off the pace, saved ground on the first turn, settled into a comfortable stride on the backstretch, was asked to pick it up at the half-mile pole, started the far turn in the two path, shifted four wide while under cruise control at the five-sixteenths, was roused while angling six wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied outside into upper stretch, made a bid outside of three foes at the three-sixteenth then drifted in some while taking the lead, was put to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, drifted in a bit more while moving clear outside the sixteenth-pole then was placed under a hand ride late while much the best. POINT OF HONOR was taken in hand while off heels nearing the first turn, went three wide on that bend, settled outside on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide while asked just inside the three-eighths, advanced to make a bid into the stretch, battled between horses under a drive into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. STREET BAND was taken in hand between horses early, rounded the first turn in the two path under a snug hold, was rated just off the pace under stout restraint, drafted behind the leaders while tugging at the bit and still under vigorous restraint on the final bend, was asked nearing the quarter-pole then made a bid between horses into the stretch, battled under a drive while inside of the top two in the drive and also proved no match for the winner but just missed the place while well clear for the show. OFF TOPIC went four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked while four to five wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong, drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and tired, AFLEET DESTINY was taken in hand off heels nearing the first turn, went around that bend in the two path, settled at the rear of the field, was roused outside the half-mile pole, traveled around the far turn in the two path under urging, swung four wide into the stretch under a drive and failed to rally. CHAMPAGNE ANYONE showed early foot between horses, raced in the two path on the first turn, contested the pace while off the inside, rounded the far turn in the two path, was asked near the quarter-pole then lost the lead shortly thereafter, dropped back into the final furlong and gave way.
