MITCHELL ROAD went around the first turn in the two path, was well placed behind the solo leader, came under urging in the two path on the far turn, took the lead while still on her inside lead in upper stretch, switched to the proper lead while moving clear at the furlong marker and held under strong urging. BEAU RECALL (IRE) angled in early, went around the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch then angled out significantly at the three-sixteenths, rallied on the outside and closed determinedly but missed while clear for the place. COACHWHIP settled on the inside, was asked on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the two path, moved out under a drive at the three-sixteenths, swapped back to her inside lead while chasing into the final furlong and was out-kicked while clear for the show. COFFEE CRUSH bobbled at the start then was hustled to the front, rounded the first turn in the two path, set the clear pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened. PRETTY LADY went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. TOP CATS (ARG) saved ground on the first turn, settled outside towards the rear on the backstretch, brushed with a foe into the far turn, went around that bend in the two path and failed to threaten. KABELLA bumped with a rival at the start, went around the first turn in the two path, settled at the rear, brushed with a foe leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. DREAMS ARE FREE stumbled badly at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch then drifted in near the three-sixteenths, drifted out outside the furlong marker and failed to respond.
