The owner of the winner will receive a complimentary 2007 nomination to Rockport Harbor. The breeder of the winner will receive a complimentary 2007 nomination to Consolidator. BEL AIR BEAUTY, never far back and saving ground from early on, continued from the rail around the far turn and into the stretch, angled four wide, bumped for a stride with COTTON BLOSSOM while rallying, then wore down UNTOUCHED TALENT under strong handling. UNTOUCHED TALENT went up to press front-running APPEALING ZOPHIE from the beginning, gained a narrow advantage nearing the stretch, was engaged by the winner about the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. HER MAJESTY, fractious in the gate prior to the start, was unhurried, raced in behind rivals, came out five wide for the drive and managed a mild gain. COTTON BLOSSOM, always well placed and four or five wide, was bumped lightly by the winner entering the upper stretch and lacked a final response. GATORIZE, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild run into the upper stretch six wide and failed to sustain the bid. APPEALING ZOPHIE moved to the front early, raced in the two path, made the pace until the head of the lane and weakened. GET READY BERTIE settled early, reached easy striking distance when put to a drive near the inside approaching the stretch but lacked a response. SHE'S INCLUDED bobbed at the break, was never far back, raced between foes three or four wide and was empty in the drive. BEAUTIFUL VENUE moved inside, was outrun to the stretch and not a threat while improving position. CALL THE KITTY, sluggish to begin, was not a factor. X STAR raced forwardly near the inside for six furlongs and tired. PRO PINK was finished leaving the backstretch. LISA M never was prominent. BOAT'S GHOST faded after six furlongs.
