1 MILE. (1.342) STAKES. Purse \$60,000 (Includes \$30,000 Other Sources) ALLEN BOGAN MEMORIAL S. FOR ACCREDITED TEXAS-BRED FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start with \$60,000 guaranteed of which \$36,000 to the owner of the winner, \$12,000 to second, \$6,600 to third, \$3,600 to fourth and \$1,800 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; \$25,000 since November 1, 2005, 5 lbs.; \$20,000 in 2005 -2006, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered; n weight allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2005-2006 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, June 29, 2006 with 24 nomination ns.

Bay Filly, (Jan), by Magic Cat - Pleasuretohave by Alysheba. Trainer Calhoun Bret W.. Bred by Clarence Scharbauer Jr.(TX). SHESABIGCAT was hustled to the lead, set the pace through solid fractions, was set down at the top of the stretch, extended the lead into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. GO GIRLFRIEND GO brushed with a rival just after the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the far turn, shifted out near the furlong marker and earned the place while unable to threaten the winner. I. B.'S HALO shifted out on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased the leader on the far turn then weakened and just missed the place. CRESCENT LAKE came out at the start, was caught four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SHONS SECRET broke outward and was off slow, lagged near the back of the field, shifted out and bumped with VELVET ANGEL midway through the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly. BRUSHABYBABY was reserved towards the rear of the field, failed to respond when roused and never reached contention. COOKIN'S CAST went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed, raced just off the rail on the far turn and faded. SNICKER SLEW brushed with a rival just after the start, was caught five wide on the first turn and showed little. VELVET ANGEL bobbled after the start, steadied while four then five wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, bumped with SHONS SECRET while three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, was forced four wide and failed to threaten.
