1st MILE. (1:48⁴) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Alydar S.FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NEVER WON A SWEEPSTAKE IN 2015 OTHER THAN STATE-BRED. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2015 allowed 8 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday July 25, 2015 with 23 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (Clear 79)

BAY OF PLENTY established the front into the first turn while three wide, shook safely away under light coaxing before settling in hand three to four paths off the rail in the backside, marshaled the field through sensible splits before coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, widened away midway on the far turn, tucked to the inside with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and held clear to the wire albeit seeing his margin cut into late while scoring in Bill Daly fashion. MYLUTE taken in hand off heels at the start as DREAM SATURDAY veered outwards, immediately crossed to the inside after the break to save ground through the first turn, loped along unhurried at the back along the fence until tipped out to the two path with five-eighths to go and subsequently three wide just inside the half mile pole, came under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, angled sharply five wide into upper stretch and then to the six path into the clear around PALACE MALICE, offered up a good finish to cut into the winner late on while clear for the place honors. NECK 'N NECK chased the pace along the inside from mid pack, lost position midway on the far turn more a product of patient handling as other rivals got busy three furlongs out, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to safely procure the show honors. PALACE MALICE off half a beat slow, raced three to four wide through the first turn coaxed along from the midway point on that turn, chased three to four wide down the backside stacked outside a pair, advanced mildly midway on the turn and swung five wide at the quarter pole, improved position for the last major share while making no headway on the front through the drive. NOBLE MOON bobbled slightly at the start and recovered to chased three to four wide in closest pursuit of the leader, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the lane. SOUPER LUCKY away well, raced four wide into the first turn before making his way three wide midway and finally to the two path with six furlongs to go, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun just off the inside for home and weakened in the stretch. GOLDEN TICKET tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into prominence moving into the place spot, came up empty under a drive through the final furlong and lost position to the wire. EMPIRE DREAMS two to three wide between foes in mid pack, came under urging three furlongs out, angled four wide at the quarter pole and offered no response. MEXIKOMA four wide through the first turn, chased the pace four to five wide from near the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled five to six wide for home and made no impact. DREAM SATURDAY veered out at the start forcing MYLUTE to be taken in hand over heels, chased the pace four to five wide from near the rear, came under a ride taking the overland route three-eighths from home, swung five wide for home and proved no menace. C J'S AWESOME four to five wide through the first turn, raced three to four wide just off pace early on, came under urging three furlongs out in retreat, angled five wide for home and faltered in the drive.
