Chestnut Colt, (Aug), by Northern Afleet - Magic Раfaelа (BRZ) by Royal Academy. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Stud TNT(BRZ).

VITORIA OLIMPICA (BRZ) came away in good order, went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, stalked the pace on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked after turning into the stretch, came under a drive, was put to a left-handed whip near the eighth-pole, dueled with EASTER GIFT in the final furlong and proved best under good handling. EASTER GIFT dropped back in the early going, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled at the rear of the field, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide while advancing at the five-sixteenths, made a bid at the top of the stretch, came under a drive while on the outside, was put to the whip while on the even terms with the winner leaving the eighth-pole, dueled with that rival in the final furlong and missed while able to get the show. PERCUSSION went to the front, raced inside while in hand on the first turn, drifted out entering the backstretch, was guided back a bit closer to the inside, set the pace while off the rail, vied off the inside while under urging on the far turn, came under the whip at the five-sixteenths, lost the advantage in upper stretch, fought into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the show. AUSSI AUSTIN was eager off heels while close to the rail on the first turn, raced just off the pace while under restraint, stayed behind the pacesetter in the two to three path despite room along the rail on the backstretch, bided his time while off the rail on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch, came under the whip while chasing the vanguard and lacked the needed kick then missed the show. CSABA went three then two wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, was urged along while three wide and between horses on the far turn, came under the whip at the quarter-pole, dropped out into upper stretch then gave way.
