ARSON SQUAD forwardly placed three wide, challenged from that path after six furlongs and drew clear under steady urging. FLYING PRIVATE within striking distance three wide, moved out a path when advancing on the second turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. ENRICHED forced the pace in hand, challenged after five furlongs, gained a short lead approaching the stretch but weakened late. PROM SHOES outrun near the rail, swung to the outside for the drive and made a late gain. CHOCOLATE CANDY within striking distance off the inside, moved out five wide leaving the second turn and lacked a rally. COOL COAL MAN a bit eager when taken back into the first turn, raced behind the leader inside, was boxed in on the second turn then lacked a bid in the stretch. MACHO AGAIN reserved for a half, made a four wide run on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. FRIESAN FIRE set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. BULLSBAY outrun, drifted out in the stretch.
