BAY TO BAY, reserved in hand while making her way nearer the inside in the opening stages, split foes three deep racing into the far turn commencing her advance, continued in that path to challenge outside the pacesetter in upper stretch, then continued with a sustained effort to wrest command and pull clear late under firm left handed prompting. GO ASK ALEX sprinted clear of her rivals while angling over racing to the first turn, held sway on a commanding margin to upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner. QUEEN OF THE CREEK, caught four wide in second flight racing into the first turn, shifted inwards a bit entering the backstretch while making steady progress, continued with a three wide bid on the second bend into upper stretch, shifted inwards in upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. ORCHESTRATOR broke inwards bumping LUCKY LASS, was collected to track the pacesetter just outside a rival racing into the far turn, couldn't produce the needed final bid but continued evenly between foes to late stages. CHANTILLY NAYLA hopped at the start, was taken in hand racing three deep in second flight in the opening quarter, was shuffled a bit when losing her path to a rival entering the backstretch, advanced in tandem with the winner racing four deep on the far turn but couldn't sustain that effort in the last quarter. KILMORE QUAY (IRE), unruly in the gate, bobbled a bit at the start, settled well off the pace for a half, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch but made little impression on the leaders. BESITOS, reserved saving ground in early stages, continued along the inside throughout but never gained contention. LUCKY LASS, bumped at the start, chased the pacesetter along the inside racing to the far turn, couldn't gain terms with that foe and emptied out abruptly entering upper stretch.
