HENDRIX settled outside then angled in nearing the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and closed willingly. FOURTY NINERS SON angled in and stalked the pace inside then a bit off the fence, found the rail again on the second turn, remained inside, could not offer the needed late kick but held third. EL DON forced or stalked the pace outside the winner, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened some late. MR. WOLVERINE pulled a bit early, tracked the pace outside a rival, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
