COURT FOLLY broke outward at the start, raced far back for a half, circled wide while launching his bid at the top of the stretch then closed steadily in the middle of the track to wear down SONGSTER in the final seventy yards. SONGSTER stalked the pace three wide for a half, took the lead while in hand on the turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and faltered late. EL NINO set or forced the pace between horses to the top of the stretch and tired. NOONMARK raced up close along the rail to the turn and gave way.
