DISCREETLY MINE followed the clear leader while under light urging, ranged up while three wide on the turn, drew even with the leader nearing the quarter-pole, accelerated clear under a few taps of a down-turned whip in upper stretch and drew away under one crack of a right-handed whip then a strong hand ride. ESSENCE HIT MAN was very fast from the gate, sprinted well clear without much urging, raced off the rail on the turn, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and was no match for the winner but determinedly held the place. IN JACK'S MEMORY broke out and was away awkwardly, settled off the pace, was roused while three wide on the turn and came up empty while best of the rest. LATIGO SHORE lacked early speed, raced off the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and improved position. RULE BY NIGHT was allowed to settle into stride, came under some urging while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. SAFE TRIP bumped with a rival at the start, angled in sharply in the early going and dropped to the rail, took an awkward stride while right against the rail near the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and also failed to respond. BACKTRACK settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the turn, moved to three wide near the quarter-pole and again failed to respond. MAKE NOTE was void of speed, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, angled back in near the sixteenth-pole and was no factor. GENERAL MAXIMUS bobbed at the start then bumped with a rival, was urged along on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and faded.
