MIND YOUR BISCUITS crossed to be just off the inside at the rear shortly after the start, tucked to the rail seven-sixteenths out patiently handled through the turn until put to coaxing just past the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, rallied up the inside to issue a challenge a furlong out, took over command a sixteenth from home and edged away to the finish kept to task. MANIACAL hustled from the gate, cut the pace from the three path down the backstretch under some pressure from ITS ALL RELEVANT to the outside, tucked to the two path into the turn coaxed along lightly, swung just off the inside for home, dug in under threat through the final furlong and was displaced a sixteenth out, then ran on clear for the place honors. ITS ALL RELEVANT prompted the pace of MANIACAL four then three wide through the turn, had QUIJOTE advance through a tight seam just past the three-eighths, came in slightly bumping with that rival and appeared to be clipped behind on the left rear side, the rider looking back after the incident with five-sixteenths to go, swung three wide into upper stretch under a drive, weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors, UNCLE VINNY coaxed from the start, chased the pace three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths. continued three wide into upper stretch and improved position for the last major share. COUNTERFORCE just off the inside in pursuit in range of the front, tucked to the inside seven-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing three furlongs out down along the fence, swung just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. KING KRANZ four to five wide in pursuit throughout, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, cornered four wide at the head of the lane, weakened in the stretch. QUIJOTE two to three wide between foes in aim of the front, advanced through a tight seam between MANIACAL and ITS ALL RELEVANT nearing the three-eighths when that seam closed even tighter just past that station, got bumped lightly by ITS ALL RELEVANT and appeared to clip that rival in the rear left hind bobbling heavily and pecking the ground, the rider nearly getting tossed out of the saddle and his charge nearly falling save through the athletic agility of both rider and horse, had the rider come out of the irons, showed great balance to get upright in the saddle, then was not persevered with thereafter spinning six to seven wide for home and having lost all chance.
