Purse \$250,000 (Includes \$50,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) *ANCIENT TITLE BREEDERS' CUP S.(GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$250 each if made on or before Thursday, September 28, 2006. Closed with 12. Or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. Closed with 1. All horses shall pay \$2,500 additional to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed and an additional \$50,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. BORDONARO sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, found the fence on the turn, responded when the runner-up bid leaving the turn, inched clear in the stretch and held gamely under urging. THOR'S ECHO stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch and outside a rival into the turn, bid alongside the winner a quarter mile out, could not quite match that one in the stretch but was clearly second best. JUNGLE PRINCE saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the lane and picked up the show. PURE AS GOLD pulled his way between horses to track the winner, was in tight into the turn, continued outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. SPELLBINDER settled a bit off the rail then chased inside and could not summon the necessary response. ZANZIBAR (ARG) stalked the pace outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened.
