WHOMPING WILLOW pressed the pace outside SWEET WHISKEY, took over from that rival leaving the far turn, made the pace to past the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. SWEET WHISKEY off slowly, moved up quickly to set the pace under pressure along the inside, then tired in the drive. BOHEME DE LAVI saved ground and never threatened. NAIVE ENOUGH rated off the pace, made a run four wide around the turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then faltered. FIERCE BOOTS steadied in the early going, saved ground and faded.
