SILVER MAX sped clear of his foes while shifting to the inside despite bobbling slightly at the break, was pulling a bit entering the backstretch dictating the pace on a clear margin, held sway to upper stretch and extended his advantage under right handed prompting. SACHEM SPIRIT, bumped, then squeezed between foes at the break, recovered quickly to gain a position off the second flight along the rail racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady advance while shifting out three deep leaving the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. NAJJAAR was settled in last racing to the far turn, saved ground on the second bend, switched out sharply to the four path in upper stretch and found his best stride late to earn a share while closing the gap. NORTH OF NEVER was held up off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted to the rail on the far turn while steadily moving to striking distance, bid inside foes racing into upper stretch but flattened out in the final sixteenth. ALL STORMY was cut off by HERO OF ORDER at the start then exchanged some contact with SACHEM SPIRIT, was righted quickly, then urged to gain a position inside a rival in the second flight pursuing the pacesetter into the backstretch, shifted outside the leader to make a brief bid on the far turn but emptied out leaving midstretch. MONASTIC was settled while angling inwards to track the pace between foes from well out striking distance in the opening half, then continued evenly near the inside racing into the stretch. NO SPIN settled off the inside in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch and couldn't produce a closing response. HERO OF ORDER veered out at the start bumping ALL STORMY and STREET SERENADE, was righted to chase the pacesetter outside a rival racing into the backstretch, continued under pressure into the second bend and quickly emptied out after six furlongs. STREET SERENADE broke inwards bumping SACHEM SPIRIT, then was bumped by HERO OF ORDER, ducked out to the five path racing into the first turn regaining his momentum, continued outside foes through the backstretch while prompted to gain some position after a half but came up empty racing through the far turn. SLAMIT tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing to the backstretch and steadily retreated after a half.
