Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Feb), by Istan - Aerocat by Tale of the Cat. Trainer Stidham Michael. Bred by Hardacre Farm LLC(FL). ISTANFORD moved away to a clear advantage in the opening stages while shifting to the rail, dictated the pace maintaining a comfortable margin while in hand racing through the backstretch, was prompted to maintain her margin when challenged racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. LONG ON VALUE was rated tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing outside a rival in the opening half, shifted out three deep entering the far turn while moving to challenge nearing upper stretch and continued with interest to the end to prevail for the place honors while failing to gain even terms with the winner. AFORTABLE settled in hand while shifting to the inside dropping well off the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued unhurried to the second bend, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and continued to make some mild progress late while prevailing for a share. CHIEF BARKER (IRE) tracked the leaders under light rating inside a rival in the second flight, saved ground through the far turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch while being roused to advance and finished evenly between foes late. TIGER BOURBON angled to the rail in the opening stages tracking off the second flight under light reserve, saved ground to upper stretch and continued inside foes late while making an even effort. RANKHASPRIVILEGES tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, was fanned four wide between foes racing into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. SOLITARY RANGER broke readily, gained a forward placing while shifting off the inside tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, was prompted to lodge a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly gave way entering the lane. RY'S THE MAN was settled last and proved no factor.
