1 MILE. (Turf) (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 APPALACHIAN S. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed, of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth, and \$2,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over since October 8, 4 lbs.; two races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Appalachian will be limited to twelve with two also eligibles. In the event that more than twelve fillies pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 13, 2011 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Clear 53)

Gray or Roan Filly, (Apr), by El Prado (IRE) - Memories of Silver by Silver Hawk. Trainer Toner J. James. Bred by Phillips Racing Partnership(KY).

WINTER MEMORIES settled under a snug hold along the inside within contention, angled out five wide leaving the second turn, finished with a rush once clear and caught DOS LUNAS in the final yards. DOS LUNAS prompted the pace along the inside, kicked clear entering the stretch, continued on well but grudgingly gave way. PARTING WORDS tucked in to save ground, fought restraint from the seven-eighths pole to the five-sixteenths marker, got through and was making up ground too late. MY REDBYRD settled saving ground, angled out five wide leaving the second turn and improved position. BLUSHANDBASHFUL was allowed to settle four wide, came six wide and finished with a late gain. HARLAN'S RUBY was rank to place between horses, leveled in to stride on the backstretch, was forwardly placed to the final furlong and faded. FAST TIP stalked the pace in hand, moved up four wide to make a mild bid entering the stretch, but faltered between horses and dropped out. NEW NORMAL pulled to the lead three wide, was collared between horses leaving the second turn and came up empty in the final furlong. SANTINA DOND was never a factor. RUTHENIA was unhurried, came eight wide but showed little.
