1 MILE. (Turf) (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 APPALACHIAN S. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed, of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth, and \$2,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over since October 7, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Appalachian will be limited to twelve with two also eligibles. In the event that more than twelve fillies pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 11, 2012 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and One-Sixteenth on the main track. (Clear 73)

DAYATTHESPA opened clear to dictate terms off the inside, angled in and widened her advantage entering the stretch, and held safely through the drive. SOMALI LEMONADE was bumped at the start, settled in hand, advanced between rivals four wide, got through entering the stretch, closed on well but was unable to bridge the gap. REGALO MIA settled in hand, moved into striking position five wide, but flattened during the drive and settled for the show. FIREHOUSE RED tracked four wide, launched her rally four wide between horses, but weakened in the final furlong and gave way. DREAM PEGASUS was forwardly placed three wide, weakened between horses leaving the second turn, steadied slightly to avoid the stricken rival and retreated. LEMON SPLENDOR was squeezed at the start and unhurried into stride, came five wide to make a belated gain but failed to menace. BIOGIO'S GIFT broke inwardly bumping SOMALI LEMONADE, settled saving ground, altered course to the outside to avoid ANDREW'S GIRL near the three-sixteenths pole and was never a factor. LITTLE SADIE was pinched back at the start and showed little thereafter. ANDREW'S GIRL attended the pace along the inside, got through and loomed a danger leaving the second turn, went wrong in the upper stretch, was pulled up and vanned off.
