

EIGHTH RACE **Keeneland** **April 14th, 2016**

1 MILE. (Turf) (1:354) STAKES. Purse \$125,000 Appalachian S. Presented by Japan Racing Association FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$3,750 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$625 to enter and an additional \$625 to start, with \$125,000 guaranteed, of which \$75,000 to the owner of the winner, \$25,000 to second, \$12,500 to third, \$6,250 to fourth, \$3,750 to fifth, and \$2,500 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over since October 3, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Appalachian will be limited to twelve with two also eligibles. In the event that more than twelve fillies pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 30, 2016 with 47 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile on the main track. (Clear 60)

CATCH A GLIMPSE tracked the pace early on while three wide, shifted into the three path in the far turn, continued three wide entering the lane, took over command, drew clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. AVA'S KITTEN chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough in the late stages. OUTSIDER ART came out at the start and was well placed early on, shifted into the three path in the far turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. SPINAMISS (IRE) was unhurried early along the inside, angled off the rail into the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. AUNTIE JOY was back early on, fanned into the five path in the far turn with a belated gain in the stretch. PRINCESS PRINCESS pressed the pace early from between horses, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened in the stretch from the rail. FELT IN POCKET shifted into the three path in the far turn with some gain in the stretch. DOTHRAKI QUEEN was bothered at the start and trailed the field early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn and improved position. BACIAM I PICCOLA (GB) was hard to load into the gate and was no threat. RECOGNITION came in at the start, set the pace early, was on the inside into the far turn and retreated down the lane.
