ZENYATTA last away, began to move a bit closer on her own courage into the far turn, asked for a bit of run soon after, swept to the fore wide exiting the final bend, clear when straightened for home, won with something left. TAPTAM pressured the early leader outside that foe, moved up to duel late backstretch, put a head in front to gain a brief advantage in the second turn, proved no match for the winner in the drive, edged clear for the place. BE FAIR broke on top, got clear past the wire the first turn in the two path, continued to show the way onto the backstretch, dueled into the far turn, also proved no match for the winner in the drive, could not match TAPTAM for the place, saved the show. JUST JENDA settled in the second flight, ranged up with a mild bid in the four path late in the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. WAR ECHO settled off the pace, moved a bit closer just off the inside midway on the second turn, behind foes into the stretch, faded.
