KANTURK KID unhurried for five furlongs in the two path, began to advance through traffic far turn, swung out to be five wide late in the turn, closed with good energy to be in time. HARDROCK ELEVEN broke a step slow, brushed gate, adjusted iron, raced back and off the inside, made a nice move while four wide in the second turn to reach contention into the straight, put a head in front nearing the furlong grounds, could not contain the winner while remaining clear of the others. THUNDER CALLS settled off the pace toward the hedge, raced in some traffic out of the final turn, steered out for some room in the drive, finished willingly late. REPORTING STAR tracked the early leaders toward the inside, moved out to force the issue three wide up the backstretch, vied through the second turn and into the lane, weakened in the late going. SILVER DAY within striking distance, three wide in the second turn, raced into the stretch between foes and went evenly to the wire in lacking a serious late kick. DECISIVE DAVID lacked speed, came in the three path into the lane, carried out slightly midstretch, lodged a mild close to improve position. L'S TICKET TO RIDE raced outside throughout and lacked a late kick. SOUTHERN TIER set or forced the pace for almost six furlongs along the inside then tired in the drive. JOSHUA'S COMPRISE was never involved in a dull effort. DAD'Z LAUGH set or forced the pace until the real running began at the head of the lane and stopped.
