

1 MILE. (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 ARLINGTON-WASHINGTON FUTURITY (GRADE III) FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each horse, which should accompany the nomination. A Supplementary Nomination of \$4,000 may be made on Wednesday, September 8, 2010, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$600 to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. MAJOR GAIN gained a tracking position just off the second flight between foes while unhurried in the opening stages, continued between foes on the bend gathering momentum, shifted out splitting foes five deep entering upper stretch to challenge, then moved to wrest command in the final stages, responding to firm left handed pressure. ROUGH SAILING, a step slow at the start, secured position in the second flight along the inside in the opening quarter, came around a tiring foe after six furlongs to challenge along the rail in upper stretch, was outkicked by the winner but continued with interest to the end to secure the place on the wire. CALEB'S POSSE tracked off the first flight three deep in the opening half, shifted out on the turn to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch, struck the front near midstretch but couldn't contain the winner and lost the place on the wire. IMPERSONATOR settled off the second flight while six wide early, made some progress on the turn while angling five deep leaving the quarter mile marker but couldn't produce the needed final response. GHETTO CAT, prominent between foes from the break, attended a rival's pace while in hand in the opening half, pressed for command between foes after five furlongs but came empty leaving the furlong marker. WHEEMAWAY settled along the inside in the opening half and never gained striking distance. WEEKEND WILDCAT, forwardly placed three deep in the opening quarter while under some reserve, advanced to press the issue in that path racing into upper stretch but gave way abruptly. BIG BLUE CABOOSE ducked inwards at the start, was quickly righted, then moved to the fore inside foes, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn but emptied out after six furlongs.
