WONDERLANDBYNIGHT broke inwards bumping CREPE MYRTLE, was collected to track well off the second flight four deep in the opening half, steadily moved into contention in that path racing through the bend, bid five deep for command entering upper stretch, drifted inwards under right handed pressure racing through the lane but continued with a sustained response to draw clear in the last furlong. JORDY Y tracked the pace behind the second flight three deep between foes in the opening stages, split foes racing through the turn to challenge four wide entering upper stretch, was steady momentarily in upper stretch when losing his path to the eventual winner but continued under pressure to secure the place in the final stages. THIRD CHANCE tracked the pace in second flight three deep between foes, made a steady advance in that path to challenge for command after six furlongs, battled inside the winner racing through the stretch but weakened in the last furlong. HONEY CHILE tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening half, advanced to challenge five deep with a quarter mile to go but flattened out nearing midstretch. MISS INCLINED, reserved off the pace near the inside in the opening half, angled out seven wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. CREPE MYRTLE, bumped, then squeezed between foes at the break, settled off rivals for a half, then improved her position racing four wide between foes into the stretch. SUMMER SAVORY broke outwards bumping CREPE MYRTLE, was righted to make some mild progress between foes racing into the bend but came up empty nearing upper stretch. EDIE bobbed at the start, was quickly collected to gain a tracking position near the inside in second flight, advanced on the pacesetter to challenge between foes racing through the turn but emptied out in upper stretch. TELME ALL ABOUTIT, forwardly placed along the inside tracking just off the pacesetter under some reserve, momentarily awaited an opening racing through the bend but steadily faded when losing her momentum nearing upper stretch. ONE STAR tracked just off the second flight along the inside, shifted out entering the turn to make a brief bid after six furlongs but proved empty entering upper stretch. LARUE LOVELAKE tracked just off the second flight outside foes in the opening half, made a brief, four wide bid between foes racing into the turn but dropped out abruptly in upper stretch. IMAGE OF GRACE broke slowly and never gained contention. SONGOFTHECITY, a bit unruly before the start while reluctant to load, set the pace along the inside racing into the bend and emptied out after six furlongs. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF JORDY Y LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER ALLEGING INTERFERENCE, WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
