ARCH TRAVELER headstrong while being taken off the lead to stalk the pace, rallied to gain the advantage at the top of the stretch, opened a clear lead inside the eighth pole, then drifted out late and lasted over NACHO BUSINESS. The latter, hard held in the early going, tracked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run, then was gaining on the winner at the finish. WASHINGTON'S RULES reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and finished willingly to be up for the show. PRIVATE PRIZE steadied outside ARCH TRAVELER on the first turn, moved up quickly to gain the lead from that rival, made the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch, then weakened. COOL BLUE RED HOT allowed to settle, advanced three wide into the far turn to reach contention, then gave way in the drive. PORCINI PRINCE stalked the pace off the rail into the far turn, then tired.
