NEHRO broke well, fell immediately back toward the inside, continued unhurried in the run up the backstretch, came four wide and trouble free into the lane, late surge to be rapidly getting to the winner in the final strides. DANCE CITY reluctant to load, broke in good order, chased the leader, moved up to challenge between foes far turn, vied into the lane, bothered along the rail inside the furlong marker, finished up best of the rest. SWAY

AWAY broke out, rank, wide into and through the first turn, continued wide, ranged up, challenged 5w 2nd turn, led past the furlong marker, drifted, lugged in, weakened in the late going. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND.
