Bay Colt, (Apr), by Empire Maker - Untouched Talent by Storm Cat. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by Audley Farm Inc.(VA).

BODEMEISTER broke out, angled in and vied into the first turn off the inside, got clear onto the backstretch, set a legit set of fractions when still clear into the far turn, shrugged off his closest pursuer midway on that bend, spurred well clear just inside the furlong grounds, steady handling, much best. SECRET CIRCLE forwardly placed off the inside, moved a bit closer four wide in the far turn, was closest to the victor into the lane, drifted out, no match for the winner, lasted for the place while between rivals at the wire. SABERCAT unhurried for six furlongs, raced in some traffic into the lane, roused upper stretch, also drifted a bit under pressure midstretch, finished up willingly to narrowly gain the show. COZZETTI lacked speed, asked for some run in the far turn, came three wide into the lane, staged a moderate rally to narrowly miss the show. ATIGUN brushed nearing the wire the first time, lacked speed, inside of several rivals turning into the stretch, switched out, improved position while not a serious threat. STAT vied early inside the winner, chased that rival up the backstretch, moved briefly closer midway on the final turn, faded through the lane. NAJJAAR last away, trailed early, swung out six wide turning for home, managed only to pass tiring foes. ISNT HE CLEVER within striking distance while between foes backstretch, had nothing left for the drive. OPTIMIZER in tight early, steadied, raced mid pack, failed to rally and tired late. JAKE MO within striking distance, saved ground second turn, gave way in the drive. RACONTEUR was through after a half.
