CLASSIC EMPIRE bobbled slightly but broke in mid pack, steadied nearing the wire the first time, moved out in the three path while a bit keen in the first turn, in some traffic approaching the far turn, patiently handled three out to four wide through that bend, asked for run when straightened for home, finished with good resolve to be up in time. CONQUEST MO MONEY broke sharp, with the early while four wide into the first turn, narrowly showed the way up the backstretch just off the inside, dueled into the stretch closest to the inside in the two path, drifted, brushed with MALAGACY inside the furlong grounds, continued to hold the advantage late, caught in the waning strides in a game effort. LOOKIN AT LEE unhurried in the early going began a good gain three wide far turn, dove to the inside nearing the furlong marker, steered back out soon after, finished willingly to earn the show. SONNETEER lagged far back for six furlongs, began to move four out to five through the final turn, eased out to be widest for the drive and closed well while too late far out in the strip. MALAGACY five wide into the first turn when toward the front, continued with striking distance up the backstretch outside, engaged the runner up in the far turn, dueled with that one into and through upper stretch, brushed when that same rival drifted out in midstretch, drifted in himself, faltered in the late going to lose several positions. UNTRAPPED settled in the early going, lodged a middle move four wide into contention in the second turn, gave way in the drive. SILVER DUST broke near the back, advanced to mid pack before a half, pulled up the backstretch toward the inside, had little left for the drive, ROWDY THE WARRIOR fell quickly back to trail after the start, continued far back the middle half, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a threat. PETROV forwardly and off the inside called on for a response midway on the final turn, had nothing for the drive. ONE DREAMY DUDE remained always back in lacking a response. GRANDPA'S DREAM flashed some brief early speed inside, stopped. ROCKIN RUDY was finished early.
