GHOST HUNTER hugged the rail while stalking the pace on the inside, found a hole on the inside with a furlong to go, began to drift out while rider switched to left handed urging causing a domino effect once he brushed OAK BROOK just before the finish but himself was unfazed. OAK BROOK got jostled around a bit coming into stride but quickly recovered to pushed the pace, went two wide around both turns, swung for home running gamely down the stretch then had to alter course when GHOST HUNTER drifted out and brushing him, which caused OAK BROOK to bump MANITOULIN just before the finish. KASAQUI (ARG) stumbled coming into stride and bumped with CREWMAN in the process, sat well rated off the pace while going two wide around both turns, swung for home in the four path and began to close willingly on the outside but got bumped by MANITOULIN just before the finish. MANITOULIN stalked the pace between horses going two and three wide around the turns, swung for home in the four path then uncorked a strong rally between horses but got bumped and squeezed by OAK BROOK and KASAQUI just before the causing him to be taken up and he had no time to recover. TAGHLEEB trailed most of the way while hugging the rail, closed willingly but it was not enough. CAMMACK tracked the pace while sitting on the inside, angled out at the three sixteenths pole uncorking a mild rally. CREWMAN was reluctant to load going into the gate then bumped with KASAQUI at the start, quickly recovered to get up and set a pressured pace but folded up down the lane. SIR DUDLEY DIGGES was reluctant to load but broke well, went three wide around both turns while tracking the pace on the outside then had no response when asked.
