ROBERT BRUCE (CHI) ducked out at the start and bumped into OSCAR PERFORMANCE in the process, settled into stride and tracked the pace on the outside going two wide around the turns, maintained his position but was forced to swing six wide into the stretch looking for running room, looked like a million bucks when he hit his best stride inside the final furlong and swooped to the front edging clear with a sixteenth to go. ALMANAAR (GB) was rank as they passed by the first time, checked with a mile to go when his hole closed in, but was quickly back into stride, got a spot on the rail for the first turn then settled to track the pace, went three wide turning for home but had to swing five wide into the stretch, took control very briefly at the sixteenth but did not have enough to hold off the winner. CENTURY DREAM (IRE) was quick into stride and had a comfortable lead most of the way while staying towards the rail, drifted out through the stretch drive and began to edge clear with a furlong to go but was overwhelmed in the final sixteenth. CATCHO EN DIE (ARG) tracked the pace while running in the two path around the turns, angled out at the quarter pole to enter the stretch four wide and began to unravel a rally, had to check when CENTURY DREAM (IRE) drifted out and closed in his hole near the sixteenth pole and had no time to recover. MONEY MULTIPLIER chased the pace between horses while going two wide around the turns but tired in the final furlong. DEAUVILLE (IRE) ran towards the rear most of the way while staying on the inside, had a mild gain in the stretch. TWENTY FOUR SEVEN secured a spot on the rail as the field entered the first turn, sat well rated off the pace and maintained that position on the backstretch, went three wide turning for home and swung into the stretch while going seven wide with a mild response. CIRCUS COUTURE (IRE) was hustled out of the gate then was rank as the field passed by the first time, settled to chase the pace while on the inside but came up empty with a furlong to go. OSCAR PERFORMANCE broke a step slowly then got bumped by ROBERT BRUCE (CHI) as the pair came into stride, shook it off and went up to chase the pace on the outside, went three wide around both turns, began to slow in the stretch then was pulled up near the wire and vanned off. THE RIDER OF CATCHO EN DIE (ARG) CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF CENTURY DREAM (IRE) FOR INTERFERENCE NEAR THE SIXTEENTH POLE, STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED CENTURY DREAM (IRE) AND PLACED HIM FOURTH.
