SAINT LEON broke sharply to secure the advantage along the rail in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin under light reserve racing into the bend, forged clear when given his cue entering upper stretch and held CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE safe to the end under steady handling and some right handed pressure. The latter broke in the air, settled in hand from out of striking distance racing to the turn, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to gain terms with the winner late while always second best. LONGHUNTER (GB), reserved just off the first flight in the opening stages, shifted out three deep entering the turn while moving to striking position, bid for command in that path nearing upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner in the final quarter. REGALLY READY joined the pace three deep soon after the break, shifted in on the turn to briefly press the issue between foes but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch. BIRDIE BEATS PAR switched off the inside just after the start while being urged to prompt the pace between foes in the opening stages, shifted to the inside entering the turn and soon faded from contention.
