LITTLE MIKE broke sharply to gain the advantage from the outset, dictated a measured pace on his own courage while maintaining a comfortable margin racing to the second bend, shook clear when given his cue entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady pressure. AFSARE (GB) was reserved off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, steadily gained contention while racing in close quarters between foes on the second bend, was urged to split foes while shifting out four deep entering upper stretch and made steady progress to close the gap in late stages while always only second best. RAHYSTRADA, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out while racing in some close quarters in upper stretch to split foes five wide and finish on even terms with a rival for a share. COLOMBIAN (IRE) was guided to the inside early gaining a position in the second flight tracking the leader, was urged to challenge while shifting off the inside racing through the stretch but couldn't produce the needed final bid while continuing well enough to finish on even terms with a rival for third. CRACKERJACK KING (IRE) worked his way to the rail in the opening quarter while gaining a position off the second flight, came through along the rail to challenge inside foes when presented an opening nearing midstretch but lacked the needed final kick. TREASURE BEACH (GB), held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, was reserved between foes in the last flight racing to the far turn, shifted out six wide in late stages but failed to make an impression while gaining some position. WIGMORE HALL (IRE) broke slowly, was settled along the rail in last racing to the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch and was steadied in tight quarters nearing the wire while never menacing the leaders. WILLCOX INN, was prompted to secure a position tracking just off the pacesetter outside a rival racing to the backstretch, was urged to challenge while being carried out a bit entering upper stretch but quickly came up empty in the drive. BOISTEROUS, unsettled before the start, was settled along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside foes to race four wide on the second bend, was fanned wider into the stretch but had no closing response. CHEROKEE LORD broke outwards crossing the path of VERTIFORMER, was rated outside foes just off the second flight in the opening stages, continued three deep on the far turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. VERTIFORMER, forced wide at the break, was righted to gain a position off the second flight while shifting nearer to the inside racing three deep between foes, made brief progress four deep approaching the second bend but flattened out nearing upper stretch.
