Inc.(KY) HARDEST CORE established position on the inside tracking the leaders in the second flight heading down the home stretch the first time,

saved ground on the first turn while never out of touch with the pacesetters, was given a bit of encouragement heading into the second turn still racing inside, relaxed in behind the top two from the midpoint of that bend to the quarter pole and which point he was angled three wide and asked for more, drifted out to the six path heading into the stretch, was straightened out while shifting back in at that juncture, found his best stride approaching the furlong marker and rallied to run down the leader in deep stretch under moderate urging and edge away late. MAGICIAN (IRE) got away alertly and was kept in the vanguard to apply moderate pressure inside SIDE GLANCE (GB) heading to the first turn, ceded the lead and switched outside that foe leaving the bend, took up the chase stalking in the two path up the backstretch, was ridden

three furlongs out, struck the lead in upper stretch, was all out through the lane while maintaining a narrow lead to the sixteenth pole and was bested by the winner late. SIDE GLANCE (GB) was given moderate coaxing to make the lead heading into the first turn while being prompted inside by MAGICIAN (IRE), cleared that foe and shifted to the rail for the run up the backstretch while setting the pace on a clear advantage, was challenged by that rival on the second turn, matched strides to upper stretch, yielded grudgingly but kept on well to hold show honors. UP WITH THE BIRDS dropped back and angled inside early on the run down the home stretch the first time, saved ground on the first turn, steadily advanced leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, was asked for more run midway on that bend, angled four wide at the top of the stretch, lacked the needed late kick to threaten the top three. FINNEGANS WAKE was close early, raced a bit tight when in between rivals on the first turn, continued two to three wide throughout, had no late kick. SMOKING SUN was held up near the back racing just off the inside, stayed mostly under cover in the two to three path up the backstretch, swung five wide into the lane for clear sailing but had no late rally. REAL SOLUTION was a bit keen early heading into the first turn to establish position but was still caught three wide on that bend,

maintained close contact up the backstretch, began to drop back on the second turn, was asked thoroughly midway on that bend and came up empty.
