MINEWANDER was slow early and had a late rally between horses. LOVE BUZZ had no speed and a mild late rally. HONEST TO BETSY raced mid pack and saved ground. STARTSWAMPINDOWSKI was slow early then rallied widest in the stretch. PRETTY PERSUASION was void of early speed, angled in on the turn, made a brief bid but did not rally. WONDERFUL LUCK went evenly and failed to menace. PEGASUS PROSPECT had brief foot, drifted out in the turn. EAT PIE was close up on the backstretch and stopped in the turn. LA WILDCAT stalked the pace off the rail, was used up and gave way.
