BIM BAM stalked the pace, rallied four wide to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, vied with SHOW THE WAY J to inside the eighth pole, edged away from that rival, then was fully extended to prevail. FAMILY FOUNDATION unhurried early, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. SHOW THE WAY J stalked the pace, rallied three wide to gain a brief lead leaving the far turn, vied with BIM BAM to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. LUCKY IRISH DAY rated in striking position off the pace, raced between horses into the stretch, then didn't do enough late. BERNIE THE MAESTRO hesitated at the start, rushed up to gain a slim lead outside PISTOL RULES, vied with that rival to nearing the stretch, then gave way. THUNDER BREW reserved in striking position off the pace, had no late response. THREE DEADLY SINS outrun early, angled out for the drive and passed tired rivals. CONCORDE'S FURY stalked the pace along the hedge, steadied in behind PISTOL RULES at the quarter pole and again at the top of the stretch, then tired. PISTOL RULES vied for the lead along the hedge to nearing the stretch, then faltered. WAVE ME BY failed to menace. OUR REPENT off slowly, was not a factor. SIR BACCHI was done early.
