By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$20,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$2,000 to enter and an additional \$2,000 to start, with \$400,000 guaranteed, of which \$240,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$40,000 to third, \$20,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth and \$8,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 121 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Wednesday, February 23, 2011 with 107 nominations. (Rainy 65)

LILACS AND LACE set the pace along the inside, opened clear after a half, widened into the stretch and stayed on well to hold a diminishing advantage. WYOMIA was well placed between rivals, split horses to make her bid entering the stretch, had the rider lose the inside iron a furlong out, but kept on with good courage and was making up ground late. KATHMANBLU settled under a snug hold four wide, came five wide to make her bid, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BOUQUET BOOTH was forwardly placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch, but went evenly through the drive. GRAND STYLE bobbed at the start, tucked in to save ground, finished with a mild rally but failed to threaten. DRAW IT was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide and passed the tiring ones. DELIGHTFUL MARY pressed the pace three wide, but faltered between horses leaving the second turn and retreated. EXCITED attended the pace four wide for six furlongs and dropped out. DANCINGINHERDREAMS was rank to place between horses four wide, drifted out further on the second turn and was never a factor.
