By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The guaranteed purse of \$150,000 will be divided accordingly \$87,000 to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth with the remaining \$3,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 120 lbs. Non winners of a race other than claiming or starter allowed 3 lbs.; Maidens allowed 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 25, 2019 with 16 Nominations. (Clear 82)

MARYANORINGER stumbled badly as the field was being released, then saw the pilot take hold as REITERATE was being guided over to the rail, remained along the rail herself, was patiently ridden tracking the front runners during the run around the bend, closed the gap past the five-sixteenths pole after the earlier-mentioned opponent hand vacated the premises, waited in some traffic beginning from the end of the bend, attained room to tip into path two and into clearance in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, did just that, took off with a good turn of foot when asked for run right afterwards, emerging at the furlong marker as the new leader, saw the runner up chop away at the deficit in a steadfast manner late, but stayed on well to preserve the decision. PERFECT ALIBI stepped off the backstretch stationed in the three path, was already being urged along prior to getting set down to a drive at the five-sixteenths marker, got maneuvered one path farther off the rail spinning into the stretch, gained ground in the final furlong, but fell quite a bit short. TALK YOU OUT OF IT settled into midpack after the start, travelled three to four wide on the turn, proceeding about it as the widest of all, was fanned out into path six from upper to midlane, continuing as the widest of all, put together a response sufficient enough to nail down the show award. REITERATE made it over to the rail in short order, got eased to the outside leaving the five-sixteenths pole, issued a takeover for the top only a few jumps later, failed to kick free, getting reeled in by the winner shortly afterwards, steadily backed away. PUNK ROCK PRINCESS taken hold after coming in slightly at the start, took the inside route, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, got moved to the outside in midlane, made no impact. TWIRLING OWEN away sharply, retained the advantage, angled sharply inward coming up to the conclusion of the backstretch, showed the way, loosely-pressed and spaced at a slight distance from off the rail, came under attack from REITERATE as they spun into the lane, succumbed by the three-sixteenths pole then steadily backed away. MS HEADLEY prompted the pace from the two path until the head of the stretch and folded.
