1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.39¹) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *ATHENIA S. (GRADE III) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made at time of entry; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. All starters including supplements will be required to pay all fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 120 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Turf weights: Non-winners of a graded sweepstake on the turf in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake on the turf in 2010 or a graded sweepstake on the turf in 2009, 5 lbs.; four races on the turf, 7lbs. Dirt weights: Non-winners of a graded sweepstake on the dirt in 2009-10 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake on the dirt in 2010 or four races on the dirt, 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt weights will apply and it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, October 2, 2010 with 31 Nominations and 1 Supplement. (Clear 58)

EYE OF TAURUS reserved within striking distance along the outside, was taken out to the three path coming to the three-eighths pole, swung from there into the stretch while being asked for run, gained readily during the run through the furlong grounds to poke a head in front at the eighth pole, then drew away while being kept busy to the end. MARY'S FOLLIES saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for a response after entering the stretch and came home willingly to grab second. MISSIT (IRE) underwent a wide journey, came four wide into the lane, already having been put to a drive, and rallied well enough to earn the show. STRIKE THE BELL strung out in the three path around the opening bend, settled into the two path for the run down the backstretch, was taken outward again during the run around the far turn, fanned five wide into the stretch, but was outfinished for third. MISS CATALYST bumped between rivals at the start, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled outward at that point and improved position. DARJEELING accompanied the pacesetter, offered some resistance to rating tactics being applied by the rider, acted more kindly approaching the far turn, continued to prompt the leader until the quarter pole before backing off. GIANT MOVER sprang out of the inside slot to grab an instant lead, showed the way, well rated towards the inside, continued along on the same scenario on the second turn, was let out a notch with several rivals starting to apply pressure nearing the top of the lane and succumbed. TOTTIE (GB) bumped at the start, was six wide at the head of the lane but failed to muster any stretch offering. TRIX IN THE CITY broke through the gate at the start, proceeded to bump lightly with MISS CATALYST after coming out at the break, tracked the leader from the inside and faded.
